

Mariposas Rebeldes provides resources and opportunities to practice gardening, ecology, and food autonomy for QTIPOC (queer trans and intersex people of color) in our community. We live and work on unceded Muscogee (Creek) land, primarily in Southeast Atlanta.

Our vision is to build and sustain a network of autonomous gardens, grocers, nurseries, workshops, and liberatory education spaces that serve and empower the most marginalized communities in Atlanta, GA.

We are hiring a Part-time Volunteer Coordinator whose primary responsibility will be to manage a weekly workday at our main facility in South Atlanta. This is a 6-month long, grant-funded, renewable contract. Pay starts at \$25/hr, with an expected 15-20 hour work week. Ideal candidate will be available to start in late May / early June.

Responsibilities:

- Recruit, onboard, and lead volunteers in regular garden and nursery tasks.
- Develop a weekly volunteer schedule and scope of work.
- Assist with special event planning and coordination.
- Attend coordination meetings for project planning

Requirements

- Must have reliable transportation
- Compassionate communication skills
- Must be able to lift up to 50 lbs, applicants should be comfortable working outside for extended periods of time
